for short, medium or long course.

Special Rules: This is a fun race, flying sails and spinnakers must be kept stowed!

Safety Equipment: PIYA category III required.

Race Start: Reverse start using modified PHRF/Open Class handicaps. Starting

times will be assigned so that the higher handicapped boats start earlier than the faster boats with the goal being each class finishes at about the same time. This way everybody gets a chance to eat the hors d'oeuvres. All boat entries check with Brian Watkins on

GUNNER to receive start times and instructions

prior to 10:30 a.m.

SEQUENCE

- 10 minutes prior to first start Yellow or White Flag & Sound.
- 06 minutes prior to first start Yellow or White Flag comes down.
- 05 minutes prior to first start Blue Flag & Sound.
- 01 minute prior to first start Blue Flag comes down.
- 00 First Start Red Flag & Sound.

(the following sequence serves as time-checks)

- 04 minutes after First Start Red Flag comes down.
- 05 minutes after First Start Red Flag up & Sound.
- 09 minutes after First Start Red Flag comes down.
- 10 minutes after First Start Red Flag up & Sound.

This sequence continues until all boats have started.

OTHER SIGNALS

Course – An "L", "M" or "S" (Long, Medium or Short Course will be displayed from the race committee to indicate which course will be sailed.

Postponement – AP Pennant (red & white vertical stripes) and 2 Sounds

Individual Recall - X Flag & 1 sound (Ind. Recall indicates that you started to early, you must come back around and restart).

All Races Abandonded – N Flag over A Flag & 3 sounds.
