Please note:

- 1. Stay well Clear of all Commercial Traffic and Ferries. This course takes us along the traffic separation scheme. Heed it and stay well clear, especially at night.
- 2. Read SI 14.8 which allows you to use your engine to avoid commercial traffic if needed, and still stay in the race.
- 3. Note the specific Courses for each race under SI #8 Courses.
- 4. The Finishing Line for the Protection Island courses will use the marker on the end of the North Breakwater, with a transit from shore and no RC boat. Please read SI 8 carefully.
- 5. Due to finishing from shore, we will be confirming finishes on VHF 72 with no sound signal, as described in SI 10.
- 6. Note the requirements for Finishing, for boats Finishing After Dark as contained in SI 10.
- 7. Review the Class Flags and Course Assignment exhibit for info on Starting sequences.
