Awards Party on Sunday at Seattle Yacht Club

Please be aware of the SYC policy in effect:

Effective October 15, Seattle Yacht Club is implementing a Vaccine Mandate as directed by the King County Health Department for all adults and children 12 and over. Therefore, all members and guests entering the SYC Mainstation will be required to show either a Proof of Vaccination (photo accepted) issued by the CDC, or proof of a negative PCR Covid test within the last 72 hours. Please be prepared to show one of these as you enter the Mainstation on Sunday evening.

Street Closure Info for Awards Party

Access to the SEATTLE YACHT CLUB 1807 E. Hamlin St. Seattle 98112

Sailors can follow a pilot car on Montlake Boulevard, which will be available near East Roanoke Street. East Roanoke Street can be accessed via the University Bridge or thru the Eastlake neighborhood.

Pedestrian and bike routes

Pedestrians and bikes will be able to travel north and south on Montlake Boulevard and across the Montlake Bridge. For safety, please follow the marked path on Montlake Boulevard. The SR 520 Trail across Lake Washington will be closed. However, the pedestrian and bike path under SR 520 to the Arboretum will be open.

Here are the driving directions to access Seattle Yacht Club.

From southbound I-5

- Take Exit 168 A toward Boylston Ave/Roanoke St
- At the signal, turn left onto E Roanoke St
- Continue on E Roanoke St until it turns into Delmar Dr E
- Continue on Delmar Dr E until it turns into E Lynn St
- Follow E Lynn St to 19th Ave E (St. Demetrios Greek Orthodox Church will be on your right)
- Turn left on 19th Ave E
- Continue on 19th Ave E until it turns into W Montlake Pl E
- Continue on W Montlake Pl E until it turns into E Roanoke St
- Continue to corner of E Roanoke St and 22nd Ave E where there will be a staging area for the pilot car

From northbound I-5

- Take exit 168 A Lakeview Blvd
- At the stop sign, turn left on Lakeview Blvd E
- Follow Lakeview Blvd E, under I-5, until it turns into Boylston Ave E
- Follow Boylston Ave E to E Roanoke St
- Turn right on E Roanoke St
- Continue on E Roanoke St until it turns into Delmar Dr E
- Continue on Delmar Dr E until it turns into E Lynn St
- Follow E Lynn St to 19th Ave E (St. Demetrios Greek Orthodox Church will be on your right)
- Turn left on 19th Ave E
- Continue on 19th Ave E until it turns into W Montlake Pl E
- Continue on W Montlake Pl E until it turns into E Roanoke St
- Continue to corner of E Roanoke St and 22nd Ave E where there will be a staging area for the pilot car

General Regatta Guidance

Competitors must follow all current COVID-19 precautions and guidance, and as follows:

Vaccinated or not, sailors should not attend if they have been in close contact with someone who exhibits COVID symptoms in the 14 days leading up to the regatta.

Please do not attend the 2021 Grand Prix if you have exhibited [COVID symptoms](#) in the 14 days leading up to the regatta.

For all individuals, vaccinated or not, we will:

- require masks indoors, except when eating or drinking.
- recommend masks when in close contact such as rigging, and other shore group activities.
- not require masks when on the water.

The Corinthian Yacht Club clubhouse will be available to all competitors and guests for regatta prep, restrooms, gear storage and bar will be open Friday and Saturday after racing.
